The iArts Exhibition in our galleries for July and August was made possible through a generous grant from the J. Marion Sims Foundation. Our grant, iArts – Creative Learning Through Technology, contained an important goal to teach visual arts through the use of small electronic tablets and each artist's creativity and imagination. In 2016, the Lancaster County Council of the Arts purchased 22 tablets to be used at Southside Early Childhood Center for the pre-K students in Arts Therapy Classes. the children who registered for the Photography Class in Arts and Sciences Camps and the adult consumers at Lancaster Chester Disabilities and Special Needs.

Through the use of the tablets, carefully selected programs designed for the creation of art and the guidance of a terrific instructor, Liz Bell, this exhibit was born!
