The iArts Exhibition in our galleries for July and August was made possible through a generous grant from the J. Marion Sims Foundation. Our grant, iArts – Creative Learning Through Technology, contained an important goal to teach visual arts through the use of small electronic tablets and each artist's creativity and imagination. In 2016, the Lancaster County Council of the Arts purchased 22 tablets to be used at Southside Early Childhood Center for the pre-K students in Arts Therapy Classes, the children who registered for the Photography Class in Arts and Sciences Camps and the adult consumers at Lancaster Chester Disabilities and Special Needs.

Through the use of the tablets, carefully selected programs designed for the creation of art and the guidance of a terrific instructor, Liz Bell, this exhibit was born! It is quite extraordinary, these 31 pieces. They were expertly framed, matted and installed this summer by Mark Plyler at Picture Perfect.

We held a reception for our artists at Disabilities and Special Needs in August and you will see some of their pictures in this newsletter. Nothing quite touches us so deeply than to see the pride and happiness shown by these artists when they see their masterpieces displayed on our gallery walls.

Special thanks to the J. Marion Sims Foundation, our Kennedy Center Partnership Team, the Board and Staff of the Lancaster County Council of the Arts, the Lancaster County School District, City of Lancaster and the staff of the Lancaster Chester Disabilities and Special Needs Board for their many ways of supporting this project.
